

2025 Madera Curbside Clean Up Event

February 17th - March 14th






PLEASE SEPARATE METALS, APPLIANCES, MATTRESSES, ELECTRONICS, GREEN WASTE, AND GENERAL TRASH
NO LOOSE DEBRIS WILL BE ACCEPTED - PLEASE BOX OR CONTAINERIZE ALL MATERIALS

This event is exclusively available to single family properties within the Madera City limits. This does not include the unincorporated areas of Madera, multi-family dwellings, or commercial businesses.

A detailed map with your assigned cleanup day is included with this flyer and is also available on the City's website at madera.gov/curbside.

Prohibited items will be left curbside and items must be removed by the resident **WITHIN 24 HOURS** after the scheduled clean up date.

-  Place items 6 inches away from the curb. Do not block sewer vents, storm water inlets, mailboxes or fire hydrants.
-  Do not set out materials more than 72 hours before your scheduled collection (see map), or after 6am on your scheduled cleanup date.
-  Please separate all debris, appliances, mattresses, electronics, green waste, and trash.

- Do not block sewer vents, water inlets, mailboxes, or fire hydrants
- Remove portable basketball hoops from street and/or curb area

We will NOT be accepting the following items:

- Lawnmowers or any other two stroke motors
- Any auto parts or tires
- Construction or demolition material
- Any light bulbs/fluorescent tubes
- Flammable or hazardous material (motor oil, grease, or coolant)
- Acids, oxidizers, and bases (pool chemicals and cleaners)
- Pesticides and herbicides
- Hypodermic needles or medical waste
- Paint, paint thinners, lacquers, or wood stains
- Any liquids
- Any types of batteries or any item containing batteries
- Dirt, rock, sod, or asphalt
- 50 gallons drums
- Items over 4' in length and items over 150 lbs
- Compressed gas cylinders and propane tanks



Any prohibited items left at curbside will be left and must be removed by the resident within 24 hours after the event.
