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# **INTRODUCTION**

The City of Madera is seeking Statements of Qualifications (SOQ) from interested firms to prepare estimates for the rehabilitation/ reconstruction or placement of a manufactured home on the site of a single-family dwelling.

## **BACKGROUND**

The Grants Department administers HOME funds for its owner-occupied, single-family, residential rehabilitation program. This program provides zero interest, deferred payment loans to eligible owner-occupants of single-family dwellings for the repair of health, safety and ADA improvements.

## PROJECT DESCRIPTION

The general services to be provided from the consultant are outlined below. The project is a 960 square foot, two bedroom, one bath, approximately 71 year-old dwelling. The estimate(s) shall include the following:

- Repair/reconstruction or placement of a manufactured home on the site of a singlefamily dwelling.
- 2. Water and sewer connections. Sewer service connection to include a cleanout per City standards.
- 3. Construction of garage, carport, porch, patio or other structures attached to the home.
- 4. Incorporate the following required structural setbacks:
  - Front Yard: 15 feet to living space, 20 feet to garage/carpot
  - Interior Side Yard: 5 feet
  - Rear Yard: 10 feet where no windows face rear
- 5. Incorporate all required open space standards in MMC §10-3.509 (R; Minimum Open Space).
- 6. An estimate for a detailed landscaping plan prepared by a licensed landscape architect consistent with the requirements of the State of California's Model Water Efficient Landscape Ordinance (MWELO), and shall include:
  - Landscaped areas provided with permanent automatic irrigation systems.

- A detailed planting list for landscaping, with the number, size, spacing (where applicable) and species of all plantings shall be included as part of the approved landscaping plan.
- 7. At least one (1) covered parking space on the site at all times. If a carport is proposed, it shall be constructed of wood material or better quality. If a garage is proposed, it shall be constructed and painted to match the approved exterior material of the manufactured house.
- 8. The reconstructed dwelling shall not be constructed of TI-II siding. The exterior material shall be of stucco quality or better and shall be approved by the City of Madera Planning Department.
- 9. Proposed driveway approach constructed per current City and ADA standards.
- 10. Construction of sidewalk, curb and gutter in its ultimate location along the entire parcel frontage per City standards. An unimpeded ADA path of travel shall be maintained at all times.
- 11. All required fees for completion of the project shall be included in the estimate. Fees due may include, but shall not be limited to the following: encroachment permit processing and improvement inspection fees, and improvements within the City right-of-way fees for an Encroachment Permit from the Engineering Division.
- 12. Incorporate noise study mitigations.

## **PROJECT SITE**

The City has identified the dwelling and expects to confirm the specific location no later than the time a notice to proceed is issued to the estimator selected to perform the professional estimation services for the project.

## STATEMENT OF QUALIFICATIONS REQUIREMENTS

#### I. Statement Outline

To be considered responsive to this Request for Statement of Qualifications (SOQ), your submittal shall specifically include the following SOQ Outline:

- A. Cover letter signed by a duly authorized person.
- B. Overview of the Estimator/Firm and proposed sub-consultants (if any).
- C. Summary description of similar projects completed by the Estimator/Firm and sub-consultants completed in the last five (5) years.
- D. Resumes for the project manager and key staff including education, relevant past project experience and description of their assignment on this project.
- E. Work Plan listing the proposed tasks along with a brief description of the tasks.
- F. Milestone Project Schedule for estimation, landscaping plan and noise study with mitigations.
- G. Listing of client references.

#### IV. Scope of Services

- A. Define project scope.
- B. Prepare site assessment report.

- C. Prepare estimation for residential rehabilitation/reconstruction, noise study with mitigations and architectural landscaping plan.
- D. Prepare rehabilitation/reconstruction or placement of a manufactured home scenarios and site improvement options.

# V. <u>Selection Process</u>

The City reserves the right to make the selection of a consultant based on any or all factors of value, whether quantitatively identifiable or not, including, but not limited to, the anticipated initiative and ability of the consultant to perform the services set forth herein. It is the intent of this solicitation to select a qualified consultant who will provide the City quality professional consulting services at the best value and to complete the proposed project in a timely fashion,. The City will conduct an evaluation of all Statements of Qualifications submitted by respondents. The panel's criteria in its evaluation of the SOQs includes (not necessarily in this order): experience with related projects, educational background related to discipline, quality of past experience with related projects, quality of past performance on similar projects, adequate staffing to perform work and references.

The selection committee will use the following criteria to evaluate the SOQs:

From the SOQs submitted, a selection panel may select the firm best able to meet the needs of this project, or may create a "short list" of several firms to meet with a panel to discuss the project and the firm's qualifications. The consultant deemed most qualified by the selection panel will be required to prepare a detailed scope of services and a milestone schedule bar chart for the project.

#### VI. Fee Determination

The final compensation amount for professional estimating services will be negotiated with the selected consultant. The selected consultant and the City shall mutually develop the final scope of services to be provided prior to cosultant preparing the final detailed compensation proposal. In the event negotiations fail with this firm, the City will terminate the negotiations and commence negotiations with the next ranked firm. This process shall continue until an agreement is reached on a fair and equitable fee. This solicitation for SOQs does not commit

the City to enter into a contract or to pay any costs incurred in the preparation of the SOQ. The City reserves the right to accept or reject any SOQs and to negotiate with any qualified consultant, or to cancel in part or in its entirety this solicitation for SOQs.
