

The River Trail runs along the Fresno River greenway in Madera, providing a recreation and transportation corridor for Madera residents. There are two completed sections that are separated by a railroad track and Gateway Dr. The City has received funding to complete an undercrossing that will connect the two sections of the trail. The trail will also be extended to the east city limits and adjoining trails will be connected as the city is able to secure funding.




