



NEW CDBG FUNDING OPPORTUNITIES FOR 2018/19

The grant funding is available to non-profits and jurisdictional departments. They can be used for programs that align with U.S. Housing and Urban Development (HUD) Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) goals and objectives to develop viable communities by providing decent housing and a suitable living environment and expanding economic opportunities, principally for persons with low- and moderate-incomes.

One purpose of the workshops is to encourage significant participation from persons living in areas of the City where program funds will be used. Another purpose of the workshops is to provide participants with details about the application process for eligible programs and projects that meet the objectives of the CDBG program. During the meetings, participants will learn about previously funded programs and projects. In addition, participants will be informed about the estimated CDBG allocation, and the estimated amounts for Administration, Public Services and Public Improvements/Capital Projects.
