Only the most qualified applicants will be considered. Qualifications are determined based on submission of an Employment Application. The City Manager, upon recommendation of the department head, will make the final selection and appointment for this part time, at-will position.

The examination process may consist of the following parts: <u>Application Package Review</u>: Qualifying Only; <u>Oral Interview</u>: Pass/Fail.
