The foregoing documents are amended and/or clarified in the respects as herein set forth. This addendum and the amendments herein shall become part of said documents and of any contract entered into pursuant to said documents.

Questions and answers through Friday, July 1, 2022:

Q. The RFP indicates that the New Injuries and DOT physicals should be seen by a provider within 45 minutes from checking in. We have our standards set for the **entire visit for these two services at 90 minutes.**

<u>New Injuries</u> = in and out and out of center within 90 minutes; all treatment given DOT Physicals = in and out of center within 90 minutes: physical complete

Is this acceptable for the City of Madera?

<u>A.</u> The City's preferred scope of work is as stated in the RFP. The City's focus in the scope of work regarding timing for the situations in the question is to limit the wait time for employees arriving for these services as employees are on paid City time while they wait. Additionally, while the City understands the concept of total visit time, the City's focus is on wait time as the needed treatment and care is unknown until the patient is seen by the care provider.
