Madera Dial-A-Ride (DAR) is a general public, curb-to-curb, demand-response public transit system operated by the City of Madera. DAR can be used for work, medical appointments, school, meetings, senior services, events and much more. Vehicles are wheelchair lift-equipped. To make a reservation, please call:

ADA PARATRANSIT (ADAP) SERVICES

The eligibility criterion for this program is mandated by the Americans with Disabilities Act of 1990 and will be used to determine if you are eligible for priority service through DAR.

Begin the eligibility process by visiting us online at www.madera.gov/transit, or at the Madera Transit Center (1951 Independence Drive, Madera, CA 93637) during regular business hours. You may also call (559) 661-7433 to request that an application be mailed to you.

Madera Transit Services will notify you if your application is approved within 21 days of receiving your application. If your application takes longer than 21 days, you will be granted presumptive eligibility beginning on the 22nd day and continuing until an official determination and written notice can be provided.

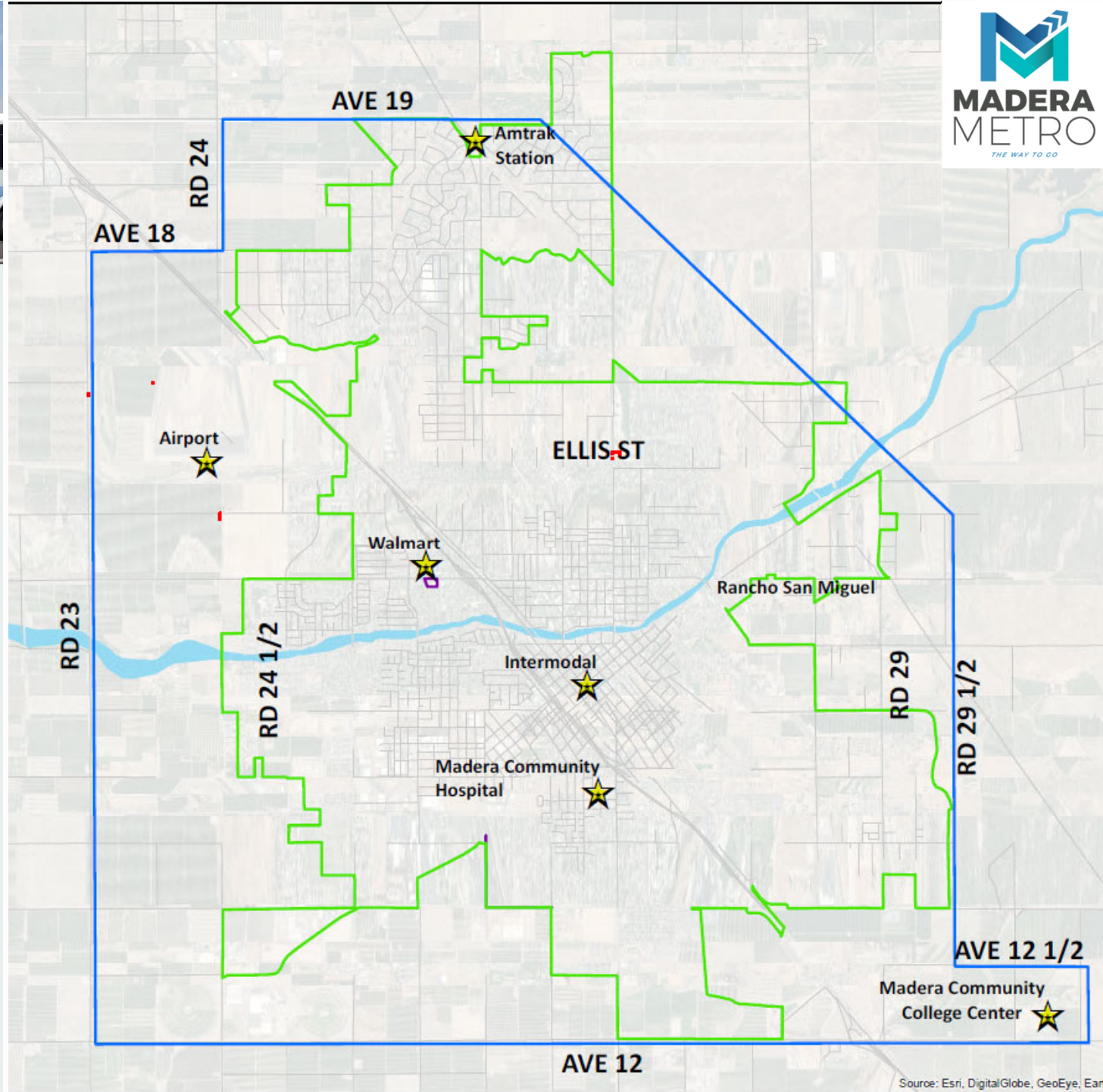
