Madera Police Department offers a Citizen's Academy to those who reside or work in the City of Madera. The Citizen's Academy is designed to provide a better understanding of the department's operations as well as the Madera County criminal justice system.

Representatives of the Madera Police Department will teach on:

- SWAT and Negotiators
- Other related topics

The academy is open to any adult (18+), who does not have any felony convictions or pending criminal actions, and who lives or works in the City of Madera. Applicants must undergo a brief criminal history check.

<u>Classes will be held at the Madera Police Department, Thursday evening from 6:00pm to 9:00pm for 11</u> weeks.

Citizen's Academy participants may miss up to two classes in order to receive a Certificate of Completion. Any participant who misses more than two classes will be dropped from the program.
