



## 2024 ANNUAL INVITATION FOR CALIFORNIA UNIFORM PUBLIC CONSTRUCTION COST ACCOUNTING ACT (CUPCAA) CONSTRUCTION BID LIST

Notice is hereby given that the City of Madera (City) invites all contractors to be included on the City's CUPCAA construction bid list by submitting the following information **by emailing the online form to [purchasinginfo@madera.gov](mailto:purchasinginfo@madera.gov) prior to February 8, 2025. This is the only acceptable method for inclusion on the City's CUPCAA construction bid list.**

- 1) Contractor name and address where contractor may be contacted
- 2) Telephone number where contractor may be contacted
- 3) Facsimile number where contractor may be contacted
- 4) Type of work (trade) that contractor is interested and currently licensed to perform
- 5) Classification of contractor's license(s) held
- 6) Contractor's license number(s) for each type of work
- 7) Email address of where contractor may be contacted
- 8) DIR registration number (compliance with SB854 – see info below)

Senate Bill 854, signed into law June 20, 2014, became effectively immediately. It established a new public works contractor registration program which will collect fees to fund compliance monitoring and enforcement, determine prevailing wage and public works coverage, and hear enforcement appeals.

All contractors and subcontractors intending to bid or perform work on public works projects will be required to register, and annually renew, online for the program. The cost to register for the program is currently \$400.00 and is non-refundable. This is a DIR fee paid to the State. The City will not register a contractor, nor collect funds.

Contractors or subcontractors submitting bids must be registered with DIR. The requirement to use only registered contractors and subcontractors on public works projects, greater than \$1,000, applies to all projects awarded on or after April 1, 2015. No bid can be accepted nor any contract or subcontract entered into nor purchase order issued without proof that the contractor or subcontractor is registered.

Public works refers to construction, alteration, demolition, installation, or repair work (including maintenance) done under contract and paid by public funds. For a more detailed explanation of public works projects, refer to California Labor Code 1720 -1720.6.

If the services you may provide the City in the future, fall under the definition of “public works”, please ensure you are registered with the DIR. Effective immediately, the City will be required to fill out a form alerting the DIR of the services you are providing the City. Detailed information is required to complete this form. If the services you are currently providing the City fall under “public works” you may be asked to provide information needed to complete the DIR form. You will be asked to complete this in a timely manner to avoid interruption in the services you are providing.
