Councilmember Evans had nothing to report.

Councilmember Montes sent thoughts and prayers to the families of those involved in the Avenue 7 accident. He thanked everyone for participating in the election yesterday.

Councilmember Mejia expressed her condolences to the farmworkers families that were involved int the accident on Avenue 7 and Road 22. There was a fundraiser for the families and an estimated \$22,000 was raised for the families. Tomorrow for the 2nd time, she will be participating at Sierra Vista Elementary School "Read Across America Day". On Saturday, she will be a part of National Woman's Day at Madera South High School. Councilmember Mejia stated that the Measure T website was launched. There are several town meetings and workshops scheduled. There will be one in the Council Chambers on 27<sup>th</sup>.

Councilmember Rodriguez thanked Councilmember Mejia and for making people aware of Measure T. He stated that there are 74,000 registered voters but only 21% came out to vote. This week, he spoke to the Future Business Leaders of America at a high school. They would like people in government to go out and address them. He hopes some or all of Council will participate. Councilmember Rodriguez addressed City Manager Arnoldo Rodriguez stating that there used to be a Citizens Academy and maybe there could be something for youth to have an active role in making decisions.

Councilmember Villegas had nothing to report.

Mayor Pro Tem Gallegos thanked Public Works, Streets, and Parks staff for the graffiti removal. She invited everybody to the event being held on Saturday.
