Councilmember Cynthia Ortegón called the meeting to order at 3:32pm.

Public Comment:

Each member of the public, including City Staff, In-Person, and Zoom attendees, introduced themselves.

Business Matters

 Approval of Minutes – Meeting of September 17, 2024. Councilmember Jack Porter made a motion to approve the minutes as presented; motion seconded by Councilmember Diana Robbins. All council members voted yes to approve the minutes. Motion passed unanimously.

- 2. Nomination and Election of Chairperson was presented by Wendy Silva. ADA Advisory Council currently has a vacancy in the position of chairperson. Ms. Silva opened the floor for nominations for the position of chairperson for 2025. Councilmember Jack Porter nominated himself for chairperson and no other nominations were presented. Ms. Silva called for votes. Matter was approved with 3 votes in favor, 1 vote against electing the nominated Council Member for Chairperson. Affirmative votes: Jack Porter, Diana Robbins, Sipho Munyaradzi. No Votes: Cynthia Ortegón.
- 3. Nomination and Election of Vice Chairperson was presented by Wendy Silva. The position is currently held by Saim Mohammad; however, Ms. Silva opened the floor for any possible nominations for change as current Vice Chairperson Mohammad is currently unavailable the next few months. Councilmember Diana Robbins made a nomination for Cynthia Ortegón as Vice Chairperson; Chairperson Porter seconded the motion. Councilmember Ortegón accepted the nomination. No other nominations were presented. Ms. Silva called for a vote. Motion passed unanimously.
- 4. Informational report on City of Madera sidewalk improvement projects was presented by Jonathan Gramajo, Assistant Engineer for the City of Madera. He showcased ongoing projects and future projects that have been approved and/or received authorized funding/grants. He presented project R94, which consist of two phases. Phase 1 pertains to sidewalk construction located along Yosemite Ave from Tozer Ave to Mace Street in CalTrans right of way and is currently contingent on CalTrans final approvals and project amount is estimated at \$500,000. Phase 2 was awarded on February 5, 2025, and consists of 16,000 lineal feet of sidewalk in the amount of \$2 million. ATP Cycle Grant was awarded for an estimated 2,400 linear feet of sidewalk, including 66 ADA curb ramps, 24 curb extensions and 1 pedestrian highway beacon. Total project cost estimated to be \$7.5 million, pending design and construction, projecting to complete in 2027-2028. These improvement areas were based on the common concerns of elementary school teachers, parents, and students during walk audits and identifying their needs. Lastly, Mr. Gramajo exhibited the R58 project, located along Schnoor Ave. Developments are estimating to be 1,500 lineal feet of sidewalk that will be 4-5 feet wide,12 new curb ramps, and proper slopes—meeting all ADA standards.
- 5. Advisory Councilmember Reports-Councilmember Ortegón briefly spoke on how City of Madera-Parks Department is investing \$500,000 in redoing pathways and cement at Town and County Park. She would like to invite the Parks department or representative to speak on it at the next meeting and have it been included as an Agenda item.
